Fun Fact: It's not just how much you talk to your child, it's the back-and-forth that matters. MIT researchers found that "conversational turns" between parent and child predict brain and language development better than the total number of words spoken. So, make it a conversation, even if it turns into an excited chat about dinosaurs!

Try this: Instead of saying, "We're getting in the car now," ask, "What do you think we'll see on the way?" and wait for the answer. Even a few extra minutes of meaningful conversation each day can strengthen your child's vocabulary, storytelling, and language skills.
